### The Denver RC Eagles

The Denver RC Eagles was founded in 1960. Since its inception, the club has grown from a small group of RC enthusiasts to a diverse group of about 100 members.

Members range in age from 11 years old to over 80 years – and includes both male and female pilots – demonstrating all levels of flying skills.

Members fly models ranging from Almost Ready to Fly trainers to scratch built Warbirds, wingspans from 14” to 120”, and basic planes without landing gear to sophisticated aircraft requiring up to 10 different controls. These models can be un-powered gliders, electric, glow plug, gas, or turbine powered.

### Membership

Membership is open to anyone interested in the hobby of RC aircraft and who is a current member of the AMA. Dues are \$60 per year for individuals. Family memberships are available for an additional \$30.

### Club Mission

Our Mission is to educate the public regarding aviation and the history of flight, as well as to promote the building and flying of radio-controlled model aircraft in a safe and responsible manner. To accomplish this goal we provide and maintain a flying field and other R/C facilities for Cherry Creek State Park.

### Club Training

The Denver RC Eagles provide free training to club members. Club training instructors are available to assist you in learning how to fly RC quickly and safely. They can also advise and make recommendations regarding RC equipment and aircraft to suit your needs, interests and skill levels.

### Club Flying Facility

Suhaka Field is located in the southwest area of Cherry Creek State Park. It has two paved runways – a 400’ north/south and a 350’ east/west, concrete pit areas, work benches, tables and a wind sock. A radio frequency control system is in place to prevent interference with other RC aircraft. Specific flying rules are posted on-site at Suhaka Field.

Cherry Creek State Park entrance fees are in force. A State Park annual pass is the most cost effective fee. For annual pass, day pass and other park information, contact [www.parks.state.co.us](http://www.parks.state.co.us).

### Club Meetings & Activities

Monthly club meetings are held the third Tuesday of each month. Location will be posted on the Website each month. Programs often include guest speakers, member “Show & Tell” and educational information to assist you in enjoying the great hobby of flying RC.
